L'Anse Area Schools 23g Budget Plan

The students at L'Anse Area Schools, like the rest of the state and country, have suffered the impact of lost or unfinished learning due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Our most recent student performance results on M-Step and PSAT/SAT show that students are not performing as they were prior to the pandemic.

L'Anse Area Schools will commit all of the State allocated 23g funds to mitigate learning loss through Intensive Individualized Supports. A School Social Worker will be employed to be an advocate for students who have fallen off track. They will lead the data analysis and student assistance team meetings that focus on Tier 2 supports to meet the academic and social-emotional needs of students.
